What's the significance of Lazarus being "in the tomb for four days" when Jesus arrives?

What do Martha and Mary's reactions to Jesus in v. 21-22 and 32 show about their knowledge of his power?

After Jesus tells Martha that her brother will rise, he makes a startling claim. (v25-26) What is the double meaning of this claim?

What do we learn from Jesus' response to the death of his friend? (v33-38)

What were the crowd and Martha expecting from Jesus when he came to the tomb?

What is the reaction of the crowd following the raising of Lazarus?

# **Application**

Reflecting on v25-26. Jesus' claim and promise here is for all people at all times. Do you believe?

What difference does knowing Jesus make to you facing your own death?

What questions do you have surrounding what happens when we die?

The main point of the passage is ...

**Pray** thanking Jesus for the freedom he won for us according to Hebrews 2:14-15,
