

IS POWER EVER A GOOD THING?

Most of us are familiar with the famous quote from Lord Action, "Power corrupts, absolute power corrupts absolutely".



During the last week I have been reading and discussing a book with a contrasting view. In his book, 'Playing God: Redeeming the Gift of Power' Andy Crouch writes, "Power at its best is resurrection to full life, to full humanity. Whenever human beings become what they were meant to be, when even death cannot finally hold its prisoners, then we can truly speak of

power." Andy Crouch thoughtfully and Biblically explores power and suggests that while it can be used for destruction, it not inherently corrupt, but rather it is a divine gift that can be used for flourishing.

Crouch challenges the common belief that "power corrupts," arguing instead that power is a good gift from God. He emphasizes that power is rooted in creation in God's act of calling forth life and he asserts that humans, as image-bearers, are entrusted with this creative power. Crouch suggests that the problem isn't power itself, but idolatry and injustice, which distort its purpose. Humans are made to reflect God's image, not replace it. Crouch explores the difference between icons (which point to God) and idols (which distort and replace God).

Crouch also defends institutions as necessary for human flourishing, even though due to sin they can become broken or oppressive. He encourages reform and renewal rather than abandonment, especially in a culture increasingly sceptical of institutional authority.





Finally, the book focuses on redeeming power through spiritual disciplines like prayer, fasting, and Sabbath. True power is exercised in humility, service, and love which are modelled perfectly by Jesus. How do you think about power in your life? Can it be used in a God glorifying way for His kingdom's sake?
