WHY MENTORING?

Many are familiar with the concept on mentoring in the workplace. Christian mentoring can be diverse but at its heart is helping people mature as followers of Jesus.

Mentoring helps believers in Jesus to grow to maturity in Christ. We see a pattern of mentoring in Jesus' ministry with the disciples, in the Great Commission and in the early church.

'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age.' (Matthew 28:18-20)



In the early church, we see Barnabas mentored Paul, who mentored Timothy, Silas and Titus, and then Paul wrote to Timothy saying: 'And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others'. (2 Timothy 2:2)

Kara Martin writes of how while the apprenticeship model of mentoring has been our primary model in the church and is still very helpful today, there are other models that also help us to encourage one another to mature in faith. These models may centre around reciprocity and mutuality where mentoring blesses all involved and relationship and collaboration are key principles. Therefore, while mentoring often takes place between a mature Christian and a younger Christian it can also take place among peers. I have been part of a peer mentoring community with others in vocational ministry for 18 years and I am very grateful for this group that have spurred me on in loving God







and others, and for the opportunity of mutual encouragement. As we were exhorted in our series on Hebrews, 'Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.' (Hebrews 10:25–26). Mentoring helps us to grow as a disciple of Jesus, blesses us with intergenerational relationships, helps us to use our gifts to serve while developing as leaders and servants of Christ and provides accountability as we seek to keep the faith, fight the good fight and finish the race.


