Annual Report – Governance Board, 2019-20

Role of the Governance Board

The Governance Board (GB) at GWAC (also known as a Parish Council or Vestry at many Anglican churches), is set up and regulated by the Anglican Diocese of Melbourne. The role of the GB, as defined by the Diocese, is to be "a consultative body, called together to consult with God, and with each other, so as to discern, insofar as it is humanly possible to do so, God's will for the church in that place".

Some of the main functions and responsibilities of the GB are to oversee the finances and property of the parish, determine matters of policy, oversee the development of the GWAC Vision, and provide governance regarding major ministry initiatives of the parish.

The GB meets monthly on the second Wednesday of the month. Meeting minutes are available for GWAC members to read on request (these were previously pinned to the noticeboard in the fellowship area when we were gathering in person at the GWAC building). Details of each meeting have been made available in these minutes. Below is a brief summary of some of the major activities overseen by the GB in the last year.

Key GB activities in 2019-2020:

• The GB reviews income and expenditure at each of our monthly meetings. Total income for the year was below budget. However, we finished the year with a surplus due to reduced expenses (i.e. staffing and utilities) and government grants (i.e. JobKeeper). The GB have been encouraged by the ongoing financial contributions of many GWAC members despite the difficult economic climate we find ourselves in.

- The GB has reviewed, and overseen policies and procedures related to managing the COVID-19 pandemic. The GB would particularly like to thank Paul Collier for taking on the role of GWAC COVID safety officer. Paul has liaised with the Diocese to ensure that GWAC has remained compliant with COVID policies and requirements.
- The GB has overseen the commencement of a property redevelopment project. Major projects in progress include recarpeting and painting. The GB would like to thank the property redevelopment task force for their efforts (Howard Walker, Glenn Batchelor, Dave McQueen, Diane Craig, Bob Barclay and Shivani Astley).
- The GB would also like to thank Bree Mills, Glenn Batchelor, Katherine Canobi and Cathy Eitzen for their efforts in applying for a government grant. GWAC was awarded \$106,685.10 for security enhancements. This fund will be used for items such as CCTV cameras and enhanced lighting in the carpark.
- The GB has sought feedback from the Staff team regarding future ministry initiatives and priorities for GWAC. This has assisted the GB to ensure that the Staff are appropriately resourced within their ministry areas. It has also informed the development of the Budget for the coming year.

It has been a pleasure working with this Board over the last year. Each member has made a valuable contribution. Each member has sacrificed time and energy to serve GWAC in this way. Particular thanks go to Diane Craig who stepped down as our Treasurer in order to take on a role within our Staff team. Thank you also to Sean Hsien and Josh Humphreys who have decided to step down from the GB in order to focus on other ministry commitments. Thank you for your contributions during your time on the Board.

On behalf of the GB I want to extend my thanks to all of our members who have supported our GWAC community financially, prayerfully and practically. Thank you for keeping us connected during 2020.

Finally, on behalf of the GB I want to thank our Staff team. You have all persevered through a difficult year and we are grateful for your ongoing ministry. Your efforts have not gone unnoticed.

TREASURER'S COMMENTS

2019/20 reporting year has been an unprecedented one for the world including the GWAC community. In all this, our God has been faithful and has journeyed with us in a marvellous way. The financial reports are attached. These give us an insight into what was received by GWAC as income and how it was utilised.

Income

- Church offerings was \$574,840. This was a decrease of 5% on 2018/19 financial year.
- Property income was \$34,824.
- Total income was \$849,218. This was a decrease of 7% compared to last year

Expenses

- Total employment costs for the year was \$519,359. This was an increase of 7 % compared to 2018/19.
- Total expenses \$828,010. This was a decrease of 9% compared to last year.

Surplus

• Net surplus was \$21,208.

Budget 2020/21 (see attached report for detailed information)

- Parish giving is maintained at current levels at \$580,000.
- The appeal for the year is budgeted at \$100,000.

Prayerfully consider your giving as this will enable us to maintain our full supplement of staff enabling us to engage in different ministries for the congregation. In addition, this will help in giving to our mission partners both locally and globally.

We will be launching two new ministries for 2020/21. They are namely, The Monash Church plant and the Mandarin ministry.

I take this opportunity to thank those who have been involved in so many ways, enabling the finance function to work efficiently. This includes those who count the money, do the banking, and ministry leaders who provide the information for reports to be prepared.

We appreciate the work done by our current accountant Diane Craig, and her predecessor Cathy Eitzen, for preparing the accounting statements and giving important insight to our finances.

Special thanks to our auditor Lindsay Coster, who year after year has provided his valuable services on a honorary basis. We acknowledge his continued commitment.

Let us as, a community, join in prayerful partnership in meeting our financial needs.

My procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial statements and the evaluation of significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion whether, in all material respects, the financial statements are presented fairly in accordance with the accounting policies described in Note 1. These policies do not require the application of all Australian Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.
